What is the NTC?

The NTC is a group of housing based organisations and Local Authorities, which have banded together to provide high quality training services at value for money rates.

The programme will be delivered by PEP; a national, not-for-profit organisation working with statutory and voluntary agencies, and local communities to improve services and ensure the services meets the needs of local people.

The Consortium members design the training programme each year, choosing from over 100 different training topics that PEP can deliver.

The programme aims to develop the skills, confidence and abilities of residents, staff and board members so that they can play a full part in developing better services within each organisation.

Who is involved in the programme?

What are the costs involved with the training programme?

- £395 Annual subscription fee
- Based on 10 delegates per training session (total for all consortium members) and 12 sessions per year is £3.20 per delegate.
